BB with stakeholder's organisations to improve outcomes for the victim support: Iain, Paul, Pedro; coordinator: Paul

The purpose of this workshop is to conduct a needs-driven stakeholder analysis to support the goals of building bridges with victim-support services.

This workshop will begin by breaking down the BB programme into a sequence of independent outputs and results. Participants will then collectively identify a range of stakeholder groups who would have an interest in each of these outputs. With a list of stakeholder groups, workshop participants will then explore how each of these groups has an influence on building a bridge between offender-centric organisations and victim support services, and what we can do to encourage their support – including identifying common interests.

At the end of this workshop, the group will have discussed strategies for engaging different stakeholder groups, and reflected on some of the problems and solutions for pursuing common goals. Participants should leave with a better understanding of the role of a diverse range of stakeholders in helping to achieve the programmatic goals of Building Bridges.
